Thomas "Sike" Dardaganis completed his third season as Head Coach of the Yellowjackets after having spent 14 seasons as Assistant Coach for his alma mater. Sike has also been the Head Coach for the U of R JV Women's Soccer Team since it began in 2004.

Sike has been very active in the Rochester soccer community since 1992. He currently coaches with Empire United Soccer Academy, previously known as the Rochester Jr. Rhinos Soccer Club. In 2002, he helped lead the U-15 boys to the United States Youth Soccer Association National Championship. Since 2003, his Empire U-16 to U-18 girls teams have advanced to the Region I Championships and captured titles at Adidas Blue Chip, CASL Showcase and Jefferson Cup.

In his first three years at the helm of UR Women's Soccer, the Yellowjackets spent multiple weeks in the NSCAA top 25 national rankings, won their 13th straight NSCAA Team Academic Award, and had 14 players named All-UAA.

UR Elite Camp

The Elite Camp is a residential camp designed for high school age players. The camp combines individual skills with advanced team tactics to enhance the development of each player. Campers will be exposed to challenging training sessions to improve decision-making and speed of play. Competitive evening matches will also enhance development and provide players the opportunity to showcase their ability and potential to perform at the collegiate level.

Individual attention and instruction are fundamental goals at the Elite Camp. Staff members are selected for their knowledge and passion for teaching the game. Campers will be instructed on the principles of zonal defending, possession, combination play, 1 v 1 play, counter attacking and finishing. Our coach to camper ratio is 1:8 and the staff is committed to one on one coaching and the personal development of every player. At the end of the camp each player will receive a written evaluation to guide them with their training and development after camp.

The UR Elite Soccer Camp combines outstanding facilities, exceptional coaches and high-level competition to be the premier soccer camp in upstate New York.

Goalkeeping Curriculum

Our goalkeeping staff will teach players the technical, tactical, mental and physical aspects of this crucial position.
