WRITING & SPEAKING

We welcome writers and speakers of all levels and abilities—all writers need readers, and all speakers need listeners! We work with all kinds of projects and can help at any stage of the process, from brainstorming to polishing. Our Writing Consultants and Speaking Fellows are trained to work with writing from across the disciplines.

WRITING APPOINTMENTS

AS&E grad students can schedule any available writing appointment, but we encourage you to schedule a "Grad Student Appointment," which are designed just for you! These appointments feature specially trained Writing Consultants and can be scheduled back-to-back for a total of 2 hours (and part of this time can be used for writing).

Tutoring sessions might include discussions about:

- Project management, including managing time, setting goals, and creating action plans
- Planning & pre-writing strategies, such as outlining, freewriting, and more
- Principles and conventions for specific genres of writing (e.g., literature reviews, proposals, abstracts, etc.)
- Organization and flow
- Revision and self-editing

SPEAKING APPOINTMENTS

The Speaking Fellows are undergraduate tutors who can provide feedback on speeches and presentations for classes and beyond. They can help with many aspects of spoken communication, including:

- Planning, practicing, and polishing speeches and presentations, including thesis defenses
- Leading class discussions
- Practicing for interviews
- Developing visual aids (including posters)
- Overcoming speech anxiety
