You mentioned microaggressions and I thought about it and I think in a lot of ways that fits and it's a useful concept, but for me it seems to feel different. Like microaggressions would be "this person is hurtful" versus someone pushing boundaries is "this person is viscerally unsafe." Other people might have different experiences, though!

Apparently it was more than one undergrad who left his lab because of his comments. I figured so, but the people who know them are going to let them know Greg would like to hear about their experiences.
