# **Advanced Series in Online Teaching**

This six-credit sequence of courses is designed specifically for UR faculty who have experience teaching, but do not have formal training in online teaching, and are actively developing or revising an online course.

This sequence can be completed in two semesters. UR faculty can take it **tuition free**, by taking advantage of their tuition benefits combined with an additional scholarship offered by the Warner School.

## EDE470: Introduction to Online Teaching & Learning (1 credit)

Schedule: 3-week asynchronous online course; offered Fall, early Spring, early Summer

The goal of this mini-course is to empower higher education faculty with specific knowledge and skills to design and implement effective online learning experiences for their participants for a variety of instructional contexts. Some of these contexts include; fully online courses or lessons, blended (or hybrid-online), web-enhanced face-to-face courses, and professional development programs, orientations, and training sessions.

### EDE471: Online Course Design (2 credits)

Schedule: Weekly Synchronous sessions 8:30 - 9:45 pm; offered Fall, Spring & Summer

Participants will attend the weekly online Zoom synchronous sessions, explore web 2.0 tools practicum as appropriate, experience the online course environment as a learner through participation in the discussion forum and small group peer review activities, and most importantly as their final project redesign the online version a course of their choice taking advantage of 1:1 mentoring sessions.

### EDF472: Practicum in Online Teaching (3 credit)

**Schedule:** Online mentoring, plus a few cohort meetings; must coincide with the teaching of the newly developed online course.

Provides participants with a mentored experience while implementing the online course they previously designed in EDE471, thus providing additional support during this early online teaching experience as well as a context to reflect on the application of what they've learned in previous coursework about online teaching.
