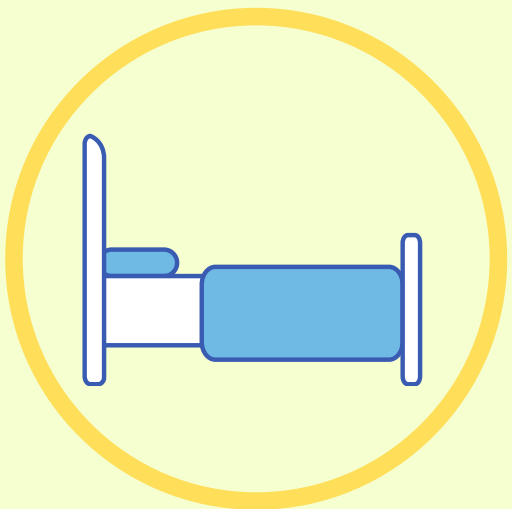


PACKING LIST

BED & BATH



- Twin Extra-Long Sheets
- Blankets
- Pillows
- Mattress Pad (optional)
- Shower Flip Flops & Caddy/Tote
- Umbrella & rain boots
- Winter coat, hat, gloves, boots, scarf
- Toiletries
- Towels
- Clothes and shoes

STORAGE, LAUNDRY, & CLEANING

- Hangers
- Laundry Basket/Bag
- Detergent
- Cleaning supplies (mini vacuum, cleaning wipes, duster, windex, dish soap, sponge, etc.)



MISC

Suggestions of items many students may want.

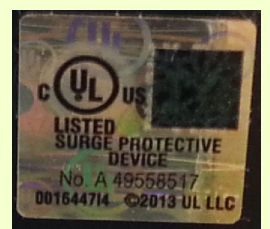


- School Supplies

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

These are common items students bring but may have restrictions.

Only surge protectors that meet the following criteria: have UL approved tag, over-current protection (switch, has a reset button), grounded (3-prong plugs). (No basic extension cords.)



You may wish to bring a lamp. Lamps must not have bendable arms that can turn upwards. Clip lamps or lamps with outlets are prohibited.

Coffee makers, hair dryers, curling irons, blenders, etc. are allowed if they have an automatic shutoff. No cooking appliances are allowed in your bedroom except a microwave.

Decorations: Note only 50% of the walls and door can be covered, fabric wall hangings are prohibited as are curtains. While string lights and hooks are allowed, the sticky backing (especially in LED strip lights) has been known to cause wall damage. Students are responsible for all damage caused to their room by decorations.
