

FIGURE 2: COUNTRIES SUBSTANTIALLY DEMOCRATIZING OR AUTOCRATIZING, 2009–2019




- Substantially declining on the Liberal Democracy Index (LDI).
- Substantially advancing on the LDI.


Darker color indicates a greater change




Expert ratings of performance over time on democratic principles

EXPERT IMPORTANCE-PERFORMANCE GAP




Expert perceptions of gaps between importance and performance on 28 democratic principles, 2017-2020





Public ratings of U.S. democratic performance by support for Trump






THREE TAKEAWAYS

- 1. US is part of a broader global trend of democratic backsliding.
- 2. Gradual decline in overall expert rankings of American democracy, with sharpest drops in checks and balances.
- 3. Public consensus over weaknesses in American democracy, but also areas of significant polarization over perceptions of performance.
