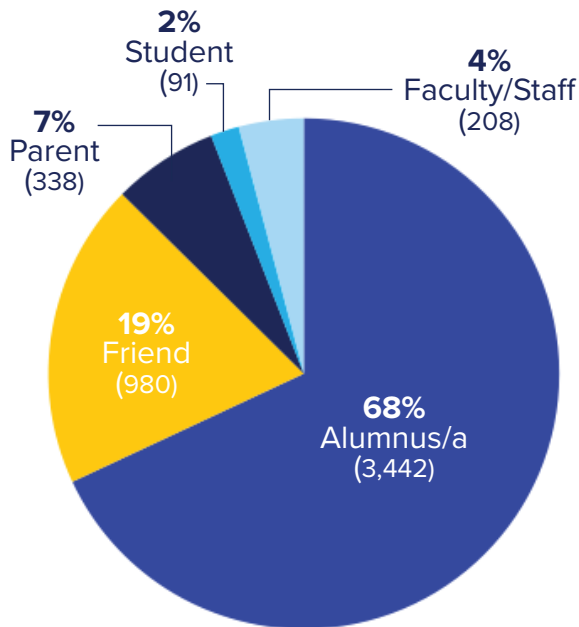

University of Rochester Alumni Board

Since early 2020, the University of Rochester's Alumni Board has been deeply committed to identifying ways to support students and the alumni community during the pandemic. Representing all of the University's schools and the College, this diverse group of 23 alumni is keenly interested in issues such as career placement and professional development and identifying opportunities to create a more equitable, diverse, and inclusive University community.

Formed in 2017, the Alumni Board provides insights, guidance, and expert counsel to the

University's Office of Alumni Relations and Constituent Engagement. The group helps develop programs and offer services that demonstrate the benefits of maintaining a relationship with the University after graduation. During the University's Together for Rochester one-year engagement and fundraising campaign, the Alumni Board formed several workgroups dedicated to equity and access, career programs and placement, and overall alumni engagement.
