- Transfer of knowledge to other challenges

- Distinguish "Need to Know" from "Nice to Know"
- Clarify for students the purpose of the course content

Plan Assessments

That Are

- Ongoing
- High & low stakes
- Aligned with learning goals/objectives
- Of varying types

Such as:

- Problem or case analyses
- Major and minor course projects
- Synthesizing information through flections/discussions
- Quizzes & tests

Plan Learning Activities

That

- Are minds-on & hands-on
- Encourage exploration
- Align with learning goals/objectives

And:
