CCC Monthly Tip

Did you know that you can create your own polls on your clubs website? Click on Elections, and then Create Election. Fill out the fields, set a start/end time and decide if you want your poll (or election) to be available to the public or kept in your organization. After you hit save, click on Create Ballot, and give your poll/election a name, and then hit Save. From here you can use the fields on the left to create a form that a user will submit on their vote. After you create your form you can publish your poll by displaying an alert or copying the Election Link from the Publishing Options tab.
