New Rule on SAAC Credit Cards

Effective as of October 19th, 2015 organizations who use SAAC credit cards and are late in returning them, will first receive a warning email the day it's due, and on the second offense will be charged \$5 per day that the card is not turned in.

SAAC is currently looking at options for afterhours drop off, however until further notice cards can be dropped off between 8:00am and 4:00pm Monday-Friday in the SAAC office.

For instance, if you click the gray "MANAGE ROSTER" button, you can perform actions like assigning officer positions, sending messages, and removing members who have graduated from your roster. Use the checkboxes on the left-hand side of the list entries to perform actions on multiple members. Be sure to keep your roster up to date to ensure accurate representation. When you need to assign custom officer positions, please use templates titled "Additional Officer #" to assign a new officer position name.
