#### **Financial Aid Deadlines**

2017-2018 financial aid deadlines have changed for all students. Please share the following with everyone in your club.

- ♦ This year's application deadline is March 15th, 2017. That's only two months away!
- ♦ The best news? We're looking at 2015 income information again. This means you can easily fill out the income section on your FAFSA and CSS PROFILE since your 2015 taxes are already complete.
- ♦ Don't forget to use the IRS Data Retrieval tool on your FAFSA to ensure accuracy and reduce the chance of being selected for federal verification.

This is all good news! You can apply now and meet with your counselor to discuss your eligibility and any concerns you may have.
