#1 An overwhelming 75% of students improved by 1 or more reading level!

We have exceeded in our efforts to prevent summer regression by providing students access to high quality children's literature and authentic learning experiences with outstanding teachers.

#2 The retention rate from 2017 to 2018 was 95%!

Planning and implementing enriching learning experiences motivates students to not only attend daily but to return each summer.

#3 Over 72% of our students improved by 1 or more swim level!

Since increasing our **Red Cross Certified** Swim Lessons from 30 minute to 1 hour sessions, we have seen drastic improvement in student achievement.
